
ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER: 08-09

ORDER

Now, on this 23rd day of December, 2008, whereas it is necessary for the proper administration of justice and the exchange of information for law enforcement purposes, and pursuant to § 211.321, RSMo, the Court accordingly enters this order allowing law enforcement entities within the 16th Judicial Circuit of Missouri to disclose peace officer records of juveniles to Knowledge Computing Corporation (KCC), so that those records may be added to the Missouri Data Exchange (MoDEX) system. Such juvenile records will be kept strictly confidential and will not be divulged to any other person or entity, but may be accessed by Missouri law enforcement agencies for criminal investigative purposes, and by authorized staff of KCC solely for auditing, or other records management purposes, consistent with this order.

Therefore, pursuant to § 211.321 RSMo, it is ordered that disclosure of peace officer records of juveniles in the 16th Judicial Circuit of Missouri be disclosed to Knowledge Computing Corporation (KCC) so that they may be added to the Missouri Data Exchange (MoDEX) system, until December 31, 2009, or pending further order of the court.

IT IS SO ORDERED.
