It is further ordered that the Missouri Department of Probation and Parole and its employees are also authorized to testify on behalf of any party in any proceedings brought by the Juvenile Officer of the Sixteenth Judicial Circuit pursuant to Chapter 211 RSMo., or in any termination of parental rights proceeding brought pursuant to Section 211.447.RSMo. without further order of this court.
