Victim Empathy/Restitution Services

All Residents are required to complete six Victim Empathy classes. These classes will teach Residents how their crime has affected their victims, impacted the community and damaged relationships with their families. At the conclusion of the classes, each Resident must write an apology letter to his victim. This letter may or may not be sent to the victim depending on the unique circumstances of the case.

If a Resident owes restitution, Court Assessments or Court Fees, they will be given the opportunity participate in the on campus work program to earn money to pay these debts.
